Land advice to landowners: Advice is continuing to be available to landowners in the area through the Working Wetlands Project, Northern Devon Natural Solutions and Saving Devon's Treescapes. There are 21 land advisers working with the DWT which is the largest number for any Wildlife Trust in the UK . The aim of the project is to replace trees lost through Ash dieback and since 2020 has helped local communities , businesses and landowners plant more than 80,000 native species trees .
