1. NOTES FROM MEETING of Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> Jan, 2020 were accepted but not signed.

2. MATTERS ARISING FROM THAT MEETING;

a) Northam Burrows; It is still not clear about who is moving pebbles. TP would endeavour to find out.
